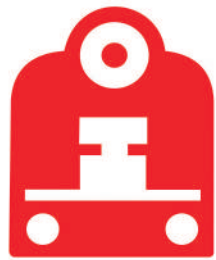

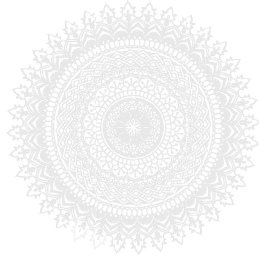

इसी क्रम में, नार्थ जोन सांस्कृतिक मीट के आयोजन करवाए जाने का गौरव केन्द्रीय माल और सेवा कर जोन चंडीगढ़ को प्राप्त हुआ जिसके तत्वावधान में केन्द्रीय माल और सेवा कर आयुक्तालय, चंडीगढ़ द्वारा इस विशाल कार्यक्रम का संचालन और आयोजन किया गया। दो दिवसीय सांस्कृतिक कार्यक्रम का आयोजन 'सिटी ब्यूटीफुल' चंडीगढ़ के सेक्टर 42 स्थित पोस्टग्रेजुएट गवर्नमेंट कॉलेज फॉर गर्ल्स में दिनांक 21-22 जनवरी, 2025 तक आयोजित किया जिसमें जम्मू-कश्मीर से लेकर उत्तर प्रदेश, दिल्ली, पंजाब, राजस्थान और केंद्र शासित प्रदेश चंडीगढ़ के सीमा शुल्क, सीजीएसटी और आयकर विभाग के 187 प्रतिभागी 9 इवेंट्स यथा म्यूजिक वोकल लाइट हिंदुस्तानी, म्यूजिक वोकल क्लासिकल, ग्रुप सॉन्ग, ग्रुप डांस और कई अन्य श्रेणियों में प्रतियोगिताओं के माध्यम से भारत की जीवंत सांस्कृतिक विरासत (वोकल, इन्स्ट्रुमेंटल), पंजाबी ड्रामा, क्षेत्रीय नाटक और नृत्य(सोलो और ग्रुप) आदि की विभिन्न विधाओं में अभूतपूर्व सांस्कृतिक कला दिखाने हेतु एकत्रित हुए।

मेरी खेल यात्रा: समर्पण, संघर्ष और विभाग का सहयोग



खेलों में उत्कृष्टता हासिल करना केवल कड़ी मेहनत और प्रतिभा का परिणाम नहीं होता, बल्कि इसके लिए सही मार्गदर्शन और एक मजबूत सहयोग प्रणाली भी आवश्यक होती है। जब मैंने खेलों में अपना सफर शुरू किया, तब मेरे पास जुनून और समर्पण तो था, लेकिन अगर मुझे सही समर्थन और सुविधाएँ नहीं मिलतीं, तो शायद मैं आज इस मुकाम तक नहीं पहुँच पाता। मेरे लिए, मेरा विभाग इस यात्रा का एक अभिन्न हिस्सा रहा है, जिसने न केवल मेरी उपलब्धियों को सराहा बल्कि हर मोड़ पर मुझे आगे बढ़ने के लिए प्रेरित किया।

जब मैं पहली बार विभाग का हिस्सा बना, तब मुझे यह अंदाजा नहीं था कि यह मेरे खेल करियर को किस हद तक संवार सकता है। शुरुआत में मुझे अपनी ट्रेनिंग और सरकारी जिम्मेदारियों के बीच संतुलन बनाने की चिंता थी, लेकिन जल्द ही मुझे एहसास हुआ कि विभाग केवल एक संस्थान नहीं बल्कि एक ऐसा मंच है, जो खिलाड़ियों को अपनी पूरी क्षमता तक पहुँचने का अवसर प्रदान करता है। मुझे अपने खेल पर ध्यान केंद्रित करने के लिए हर संभव सुविधा दी गई, जिससे मैं बिना किसी मानसिक बोझ के अपने प्रदर्शन को बेहतर बना सका।

मेरी सबसे बड़ी उपलब्धियों में से एक वह समय था जब मैंने एशियन गेम्स में सिल्वर मेडल जीता। यह मेरे जीवन का एक यादगार क्षण था, और उस समय विभाग का सहयोग मेरे लिए अमूल्य था। उन्होंने इस उपलब्धि को पूरे सम्मान के साथ सराहा और मुझे आगे भी प्रेरित किया। इसी तरह, जब मैंने वर्ल्ड चौपियनशिप में सिल्वर मेडल जीता, तब भी मुझे यह महसूस हुआ कि मेरे पीछे एक मजबूत सहयोग प्रणाली खड़ी है, जो मेरे हर प्रयास को समर्थन देती है। विभाग की सबसे बड़ी विशेषता यह रही है कि उन्होंने मुझे हमेशा मानसिक रूप से स्वतंत्र रखा। उन्होंने कभी भी ऐसा कोई दबाव



नहीं बनाया जिससे मेरे खेल पर नकारात्मक प्रभाव पड़े। बल्कि, उन्होंने मुझे उस वातावरण में रहने का अवसर दिया, जहाँ मैं केवल अपने खेल पर ध्यान केंद्रित कर सकूँ और हर प्रतियोगिता में अपना सर्वश्रेष्ठ प्रदर्शन करूँ।

इसके अलावा, विभाग की नीतियाँ भी खिलाड़ियों के लिए अत्यधिक लाभकारी रही हैं। मुझे न केवल आर्थिक सहायता मिली, बल्कि प्रमोशन की सुविधाएँ भी दी गईं, जिससे मेरा मनोबल और अधिक बढ़ा। सबसे महत्वपूर्ण यह रहा कि मुझे “ऑन ड्यूटी लीव” जैसी सुविधाएँ मिलीं, जिससे मैं अपनी ट्रेनिंग और अंतरराष्ट्रीय प्रतियोगिताओं के लिए पूरी तरह से समर्पित रह सका। सरकार द्वारा संचालित विभिन्न खेल योजनाओं और प्रशिक्षण कार्यक्रमों का लाभ भी मुझे मिला, जिससे मेरी तकनीक और प्रदर्शन में लगातार सुधार हुआ।

पिछले कुछ वर्षों में, मैंने अपने विभाग के लिए तीन महत्वपूर्ण अंतरराष्ट्रीय पदक जीते हैं। 2023 में हांगझू, चीन में आयोजित एशियन गेम्स में सिल्वर मेडल जीतना मेरे लिए बेहद खास था। उसी साल, जापान के कोबे में वर्ल्ड चैंपियनशिप में भी मैंने सिल्वर मेडल हासिल किया। 2024 में, पेरिस पैरालंपिक्स में सिल्वर मेडल जीतकर मैंने अपने करियर में एक और बड़ी उपलब्धि जोड़ी।

लेकिन मेरा सफर यहीं समाप्त नहीं होता। अब मेरा ध्यान भविष्य की प्रतियोगिताओं पर है। मेरा मानना है कि केवल मेहनत करना ही काफी नहीं होता, बल्कि स्मार्ट वर्क भी उतना ही जरूरी होता है। अब मैं अपनी तैयारी को पहले से कहीं अधिक रणनीतिक और संगठित तरीके से कर रहा हूँ। मैंने सीखा है कि सफलता केवल परिणामों पर ध्यान देने से नहीं मिलती, बल्कि प्रक्रिया पर फोकस करने से मिलती है। मैं अपने खेल को और अधिक निखारने के लिए हर संभव प्रयास करूँगा और सुनिश्चित करूँगा कि मेरा विभाग और देश गर्व महसूस करें।

आज जब मैं पीछे मुड़कर देखता हूँ, तो मुझे एहसास होता है कि मेरा सफर केवल व्यक्तिगत संघर्ष और प्रयासों का नतीजा नहीं है। इसमें मेरे परिवार, मेरे प्रशिक्षकों और सबसे महत्वपूर्ण, मेरे विभाग का योगदान रहा है, जिन्होंने हर परिस्थिति में मेरा साथ दिया। सही समर्थन मिलने पर कोई भी खिलाड़ी अपने सपनों को साकार कर सकता है, और मेरे लिए विभाग का यह सहयोग मेरी यात्रा का सबसे महत्वपूर्ण पहलू रहा है।

मैं अपने विभाग का धन्यवाद करता हूँ कि उन्होंने मेरे सपनों को उड़ान दी और मुझे वह मंच प्रदान किया, जहाँ मैं अपनी पूरी क्षमता का प्रदर्शन कर सकूँ। आने वाले वर्षों में, मैं और भी अधिक मेहनत करूँगा और अपने खेल से विभाग और देश का नाम रोशन करता रहूँगा।

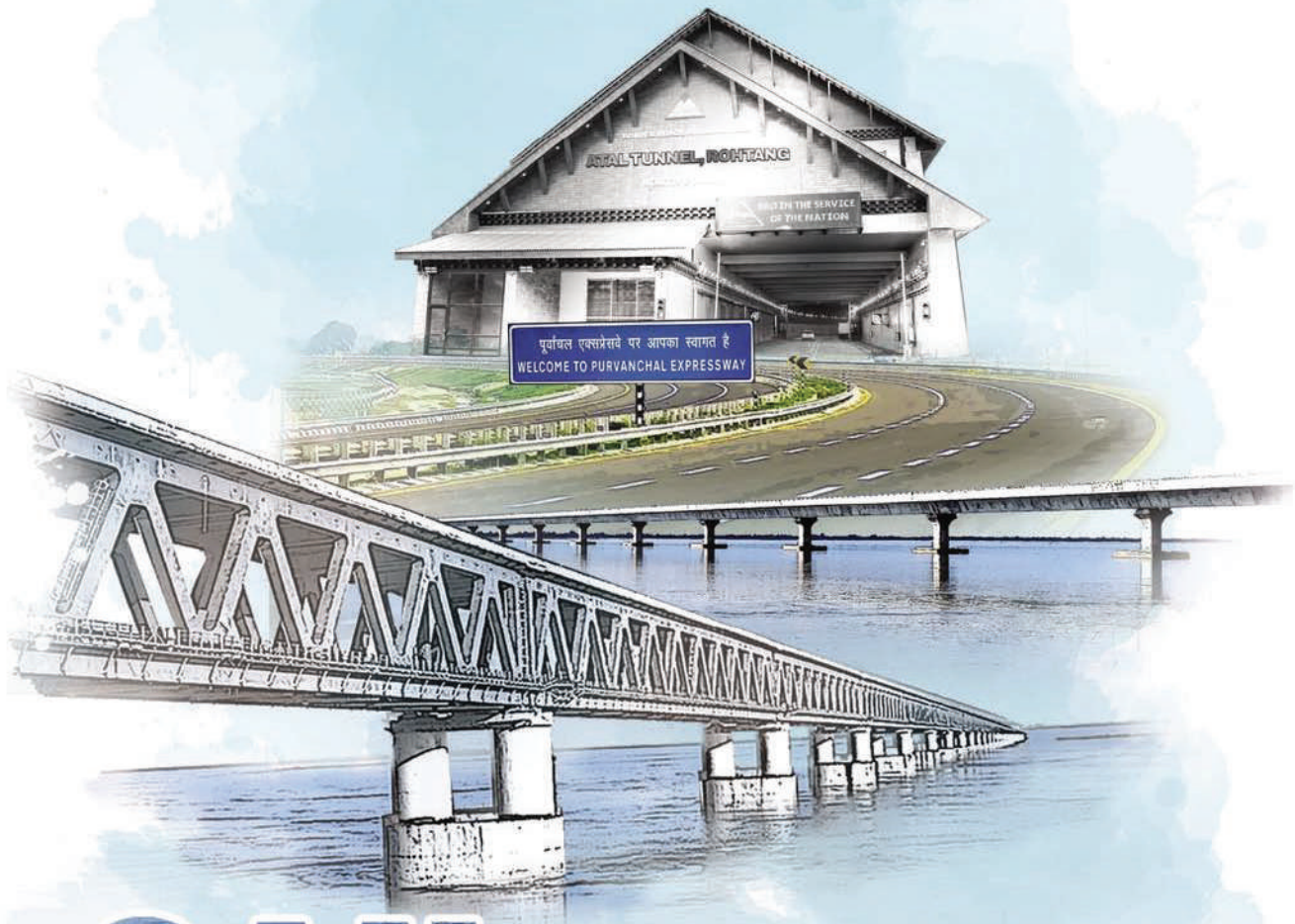

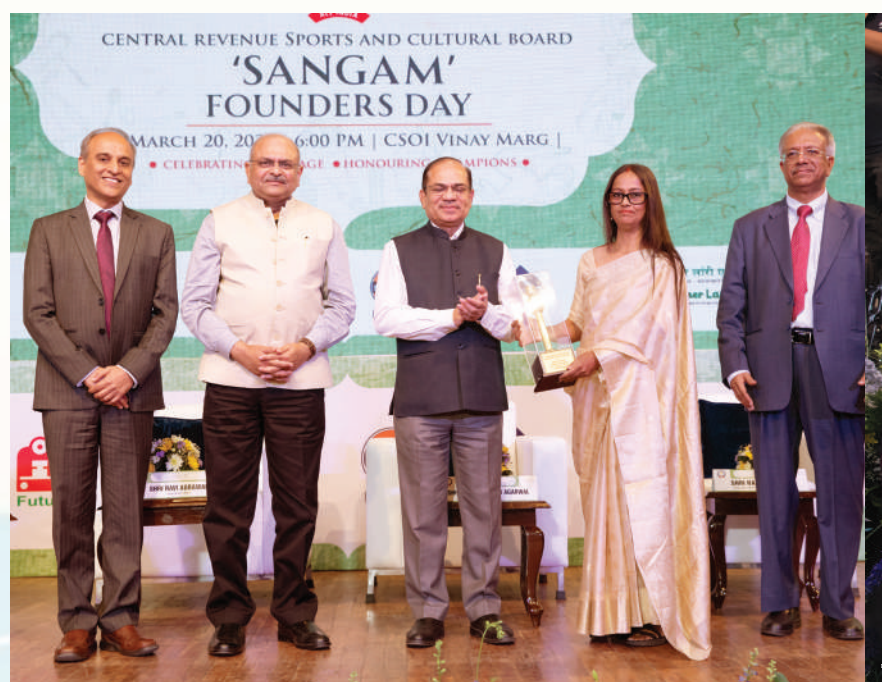
Recognizing Athletic Brilliance
